## LIFEGUARD COURSE REIMBURSEMENT



The Town of Luseland Council has adopted a program to fully reimburse all Lifeguarding Courses taken, upon proof of Certification.

### How it Works:

- ★ **Enroll in, and pass any Lifeguard Course including;**
  - Bronze Star (not mandatory)
  - Bronze Cross
  - Bronze Medallion
  - National Lifeguard
  - Swim for Life Instructor
  - Lifesaving Instructor
- ★ **Work 1 Full Season at the Luseland Pool and receive 50% reimbursement**
- ★ **Work the 2nd Season at the Luseland Pool and receive the remaining 50% reimbursement**

- ✗ Will not Include First Aid or CPR
- ✗ Will not include Re-Certs
- ✗ Cannot Combine with a reimbursement from another Municipality

This level of trust sets you apart. It tells future employers, coaches, and schools one thing loud and clear: you can be counted on.

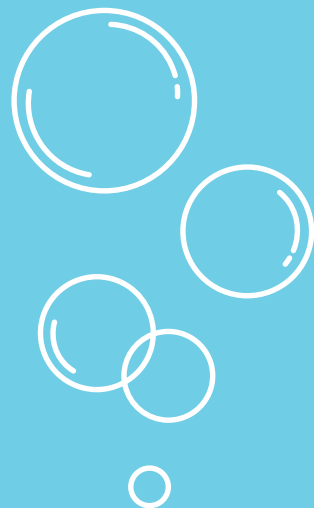
## Why Lifeguards Matter (A Lot)

- Even better experience for your future

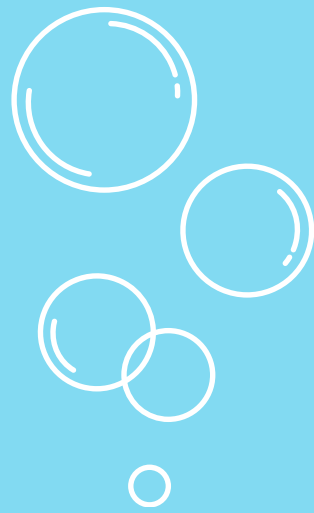

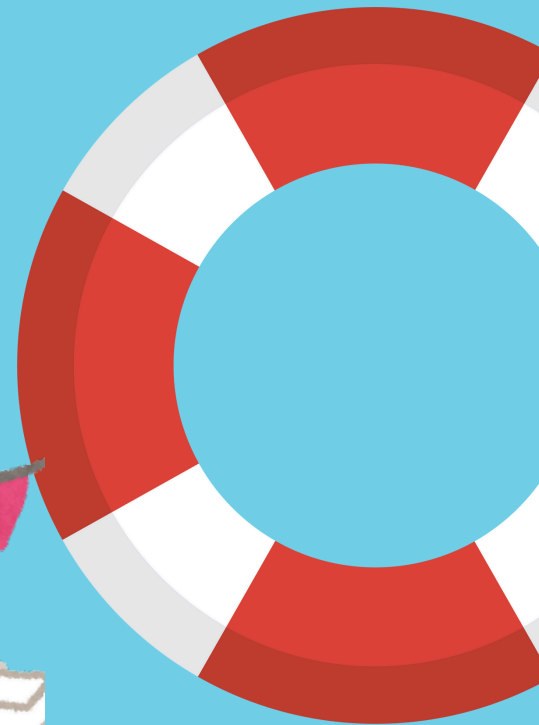
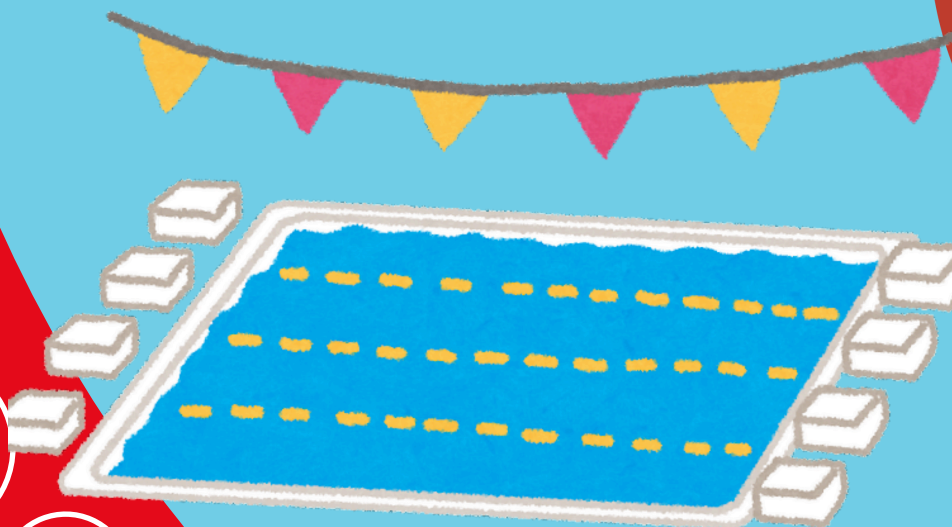
