Purpose

To give authorization for residents to acquire Liquor Permits from the Sask. Liquor and Gaming.

Background

1. Under the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming Authority regulations, any persons applying for a license to sell Liquor at their establishments, homes, yards, or functions thereon are required to have a liquor permit.
2. Anyone holding a function involved in the sale of alcohol must have the land location, date, time and type of function.
3. The Municipality in which the property is situated must give their approval to hold such function in Town owned property.

Policy

1. That it be the responsibility of each group or entity utilizing Town-owned property for a function serving liquor to apply to Town Council for authorization to do so in addition to the Provincial requirement for a liquor permit.
2. Further, that application be made prior to the regular meeting before the proposed function.
3. That the special meeting rate will apply if a special meeting is required.
