If you don't already know, 2024 is a Municipal Election year! The positions to be filled are 1 Mayor and 6 Councilors. If you think you will be an asset on the Town of Luseland Council, nominee forms are available at the Town Office. The nomination deadline is Wednesday, October 9 at 4:30pm. The advanced polls will be held at the Luseland Salvador Hall on Tuesday, October 29 between 6:00pm and 9:00pm. Election Day is Wednesday, November 13th from 8:30am – 4:30pm and will be located at the Luseland Salvador Hall.
