There was mention of grants that were applied for as well • Luselnd Salvador Homecoming Hall - The theatre is not getting the traffic that it could be getting, and may have to look for other volunteers to run it. Also looking for any ideas and volunteers for events that could take place. - Updates on the projects completed including the boiler and a/c units in the changerooms, gutter guards and water drainage issues and the possibility of kitchen upgrades <p>Deputy Mayor Kraft</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Park Pavilion - Thanked the Body Brothers Farms Inc on behalf of council for the funding of the Park Pavilion project, and what a great addition this has been to the Legion Park. • Arena Improvement Committee - Projects completed including new penalty boxes, sound system, west wall reno, header trench, players boxes, eves and spouts, Zamboni room reno, purchase of the Zamboni with the other partners and storage for the boards. Purchased a targeted leak isolation tool. The raw water line to the WTP has been upgraded. More Fire Hydrants have been replaced, and will continue to do this every year. In the 2026 budget year, a water management improvement will happen on Grand Ave at the LCU x Co-op. • Road Infrastructure - Pothole repair and filling has continued to be completed as needed.
